- 1) Students may pray, talk about their faith and read their Bibles in school.
- 2) Students can organize prayer or Bible groups with fellow students and announce their meetings.
- 3) Students can express their faith in their class work and homework.
- 4) Teachers and school administrative personnel can organize prayer groups with their colleagues.
- 5) Students may go off campus for Bible studies during school hours, if approved in advance.
- 6) Students can express their faith at school events.
- 7) Students can express their faith at graduation ceremonies.
